Course Overview

This STAR programme provides Year 12–13 students with an immersive week of band performance, collaboration, and professional development. Over five full days, students will form curated ensembles, rehearse under tutor guidance, participate in focused workshops, and deliver a live showcase at the end of the week.

Key Benefits:

- Rehearsal content will be determined by group dynamic and professional judgement
- Bands can work with a mix of covers and original material.
- The style is not limited to any particular genre and is negotiated between the tutors and each band to best suit their strengths and creative goals. The programme can also work with established bands, with tutors acting as mentors to guide and shape their songs and arrangements.
- Experienced tutors are professional musicians and educators, and will adapt sessions according to the needs, skills, and dynamics of each group to maximise learning and performance outcomes.
- Video submission will be used to assign students to curated bands
