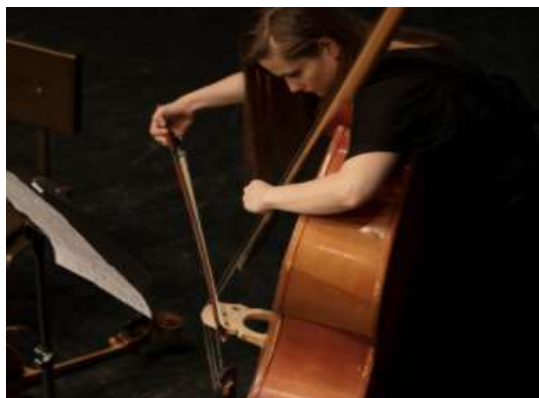

Credit Recognition of Trinity College London



Overview

To provide achievement standard credits towards NCEA for candidates who have achieved Trinity College London music examinations

Entry Requirements

You will need to have achieved passes in Trinity College London music examinations (repertoire pathway) relevant to the achievement standard you are applying for credit for:

AS91416	Rock & Pop or Classical & Jazz Grade 6 or above
AS91417	Rock & Pop or Classical & Jazz Grade 4 or above
AS91270	Rock & Pop or Classical & Jazz Grade 4 or above
AS91274	Rock & Pop or Classical & Jazz Grade 3 or above
AS91949	Rock & Pop or Classical & Jazz Grade 3 or above

You will be asked to provide evidence of this, namely:

- Examiner's report
- Results certificate or statements of results
- Video, photographic or audio evidence of performance

All candidates must be domestic students (NZ/Australian citizen or permanent resident).

Requirements:

- AS91416 - must be at least 10 minutes (but ideally 12-14 minutes) of performance repertoire.
- AS 91270 - evidence must be at least 6 minutes of performing repertoire in total.
- AS91417 - uses a different instrument from AS91416
- AS91274 - uses a different instrument from AS91270
- AS91949 - must include acknowledgement of audience, positioning in performance area, managing music and devices
